- o AVL Updates
 - AVL not installed in 2.9 upgrade
 - Tritech losing former Tiburon employees so difficult to obtain meaningful support
 - Not clear if we will have AVL with this CAD
 - Carol to continue working on Tritech for a resolution
- Dispatch Centers all have staffing needs
 - o FC down 5 dispatchers
 - o LC down 2 dispatchers
 - o Challenges for all are the same
- Ongoing research (Cont. from December)
 - At Patient reporting
 - Diane has an "at patient" report generated each month
 - PFA and WFPD are announcing at patient; other agencies not so much.
 - Question and discussion: Possible to prompt agencies for at patient status.
 - Diane will ask her dispatchers to prompt the first on scene crews for their status of at patient.
 - Comments: At patient is a challenge for the rural responders.
 - Radio coverage issues and maybe consider 800 meg as an option once the new tower is operational.
 - Diane the new tower should help with 800 meg and it should be a consideration. Transition to 800 would be difficult.
 - VHF is a constant because of wildland use.
 - Diane reminded all that LC Dispatch can patch VHF and 800 Meg if needed. Request this if having problems.
 - Low frequency of responses contributes to responders not remembering to announce at patient.
 - Reminder that writing the time down and having it entered later is better than nothing.

 - PFA purchasing dual band radios to replace current 800 Meg radios.
 - New radios will have encryption capabilities
 - Naming convention will be by last name of each PFA member
 - Two months to new radios in service

 - Solved with new radios
