Fourth-Quarter Rural Fire Chiefs Meeting - Minutes October 28, 2017

Greetings NLCERA EMS Rural Fire Chiefs,

Please see the minutes of the October 28, 2017 meeting.

Discussion Items:

- 1) Welcome sign Roster
- 2) Approved August 26, 2017 meeting minutes
- 3) Rural depts. Staffing and leadership changes?
 - a. Letitia Betchel is again representing WFPD. Craig Lasasso is no longer with WFPD.
- 4) NLCERA and WFPD 2017 UCH Annual Report
 - a. Organizational Chart: Follow-up from August 26 meeting
 - i. Advised the 2017 NLCERA UCH Annual report is on the NLCERA page of the Poudre-Fire.org website.
 - ii. The Print of the UCH Org chart was handed out to all. Reminder the chart is on the last page of the Annual report.
- 5) Third Quarter and year-to-date (YTD) compliance data results shared
 - a. The YTD data continues to show NLCERA Zones: Two-Emergent, Three-Emergent and Non-Emergent, and Four-Emergent below the 90% compliance level.
 - b. PFA and UCH have been working on establishing an amendment to the EMS contract detailing an improvement process Remediation-Equivalency (R-E).
 - i. PFA will be bringing R-E discussions forward to this group for feedback at the next quarterly meeting.
- 6) Timely Patient outcome information: follow-up from August 26 meeting
 - a. Discussion led by Nick regarding HIPPA constraints, and future ESO computer and tablet options which may give better ability for patient follow-up.
 - i. UCH to tie training to actual call types and information
 - ii. Concerns in by Rural NLCERA departments regarding technology and Internet and communications access.
 - 1. Nick UCH may be able to help with technology
 - b. Discussion about current UCH patient care forms
 - i. UCH Forms too small, and rural departments using larger forms. Need to update UCH forms to a larger size.
 - c. Bill encouragement to use the NLCERA feedback form.
 - i. Creates a paper trail
 - ii. Requires feedback to the agency sending in the form

 - 1. Sounded like if an answering machine picks up, no message left from ReadyOp.

 - a. An I.R.P.G. Field Guide AAR format was handed out.

 - i. With First Larimer County Chiefs meeting on Nov. 1, 2017, encouraged to bring AAR format up as a potential goal.
