 - 1. Tom F Response has been great to rural NLCERA
 - a. Working on gathering data for added resources
 - 2. Tom F. Pat and Tom arranged a meeting with Red Feather to discuss rural EMS Thank you for everyone.

- 3. Carol Penegree Park is a "no man's land" for EMS response. No fire district coverage for EMS.
- 4. Killpecker Tower: Update
 - a. Bill from June meeting was trying to find out who the contractor is and invite to this meeting.
 - b. Justin Bill Nelson (Undersheriff) by end of October may have power to Killpecker tower. Still need to cut trees and wire the poles.
 - c. Forestry will deal with wood being cut
- 5. Summer Festivals: Rist Canyon (Sept. 3) and Red Feather (Sept. 2)
 - a. Coordinating with UCH for possible added resources
- iii. Air Resources status update
 - 1. LZ Updates:
 - a. Tom Working on LZ updates and will share with all helicopter agencies and county
 - b. Carol D. Rist Canyon has 16 LZ's.
 - c. Theo One list would be cleaner for all to have most current LZ list and map
 - d. Justin LCSO crews will begin checking the LZ's from the June listing.
 - e. Bill will send out to all what we now have for LZ's and everyone will review it with input for next meeting
 - i. Will try to have one current list by October meeting.
 - f. Lifeline Dispatch is now in Aurora.
 - i. Concerns are tracking the helicopters.
 - ii. Each service should contact the other services that they are responding in their area.
 - iii. There is a good relationship between services.
 - iv. No state mandated multiple air resources tracking on the horizon.
 - v. Not an issue. It will be left to the Pilots to communicate between services.

 - a. LETA/911: Pre evacuation plans. Rist Canyon already set up with plans for evacuation.
 - b. Piece of Lawrence Creek Rd is inaccessible from Rist Canyon.

- i. Justin Fire districts need to assess their response capabilities and adjust boundaries accordingly.
- ii. Bill will follow up with PFA administration and GIS.
- ii. Bill At the June meeting, Dr. Tremblay discussed how this group can look for needs and strategic issues. Please think of strategic challenges which this group might provide influence or grant efforts toward.
 - 1. Brain storm next meeting for opportunities.
- iii. Radio Issues:
 - 1. Encryption radio issues seem solved.
 - a. PFA now has encryption capabilities
 - 2. Rural EMS Channel and FireNet connectivity problems
 - a. RCVFD and Red Feather described VHF radio coverage issues when trying to talk directly with the ambulance.
 - b. 800 worked at times needing multiple radios when responding is a problem.
 - c. No agencies expressed further need for PFA's used 800 meg radios (if needed contact PFA Battalion Chief Nuckols gnuckols@poudre-fire.org)

 - 1. Discussion of Labor Day planning since ends at CSU stadium

 - 1. Nick
 - a. First Net is responder broadband communication network.
 - b. FN is contracted with AT&T:
 - c. FN uses the existing bandwidth with public safety data as a priority.
