PFA Administering the NLCERA EMS Contract – 2020 Second-Quarter Meeting

 - 1. Warren Jones was sworn in as Glacier View Fire Protection District (GVFPD) Fire Chief.
 - 2. Ryan Hammack will assume EMS supervision role at GVFPD
 - 3. Brenden (Bobby) Hill is the Red Feather Lakes Fire Protection District (RFLFPD) Fire Chief, assuming role from Gerry Wagner.
 - 4. Dan Alarcan is an Assistant Chief with RFLFPD
 - 5. Evin Rau assumes EMS supervision for RFLFPD
 - a. Bobby to send full contact information
 - iii. ReadyOp An email and text test to be sent on February 14, at 10:00.
 - 1. ReadyOP test sent, no issues
 - 2. All encouraged to send any ReadyOp changes
 - iv. Communications issues? (800, VHF or StacD)

- i. Radio Dave working on it possibly ready this summer.
- b. Update: 900 text with dispatch setup?
 - i. This capability is now happening
 - ii. Need update from LC regarding maintaining pagers
 - 1. Steve Bebell to be contacted by PFA

b. PFA Updates

- i. PFA RFP update
 - 1. Kevin provided an overview of the delays occurring with the RFP. More as information becomes available.
 - 2. Mark Rode to continue as NLCERA Rep for Rural Chiefs.
- ii. New CAD updates
 - 1. Scheduled to go live on March 24, 2020.
 - 2. Warren asked about the possibility of getting a "status screen" for GVFPD Station 1.
 - a. Warren was referred to Eric Nelson at PFA IT as a resource.
 - 3. Discussion about the new CAD sending the closest unit with AVL capability.
 - a. Will send the closest ambulance to rural NLCERA.
 - b. Discussion Weld County to have new CAD, may be compatible.
 - 4. Discussion about MDTs and the extra work involved
 - a. Little value for most rural departments when compared to the costs and system volume.
- iii. Larimer County career fire departments numbering changes
 - 1. Is fully functional and no apparent issues
 - 2. Information will come through the Larimer County Fire Chiefs Association (LCFCA).
 - 3. New numbering will help with the new CAD for closest unit.
- iv. Follow-up PFA items from November 16 meeting
 - 1. AED and Auto-Pulse data retrieval options
 - a. PFA requests NLCERA agencies notify using the NLCERA form for AED and Auto-pulse data retrieval.
 - 2. EMR CE and cert update from Colorado State-DPHE
 - a. Discussion regarding needing Medic CE for EMT, NREMT and EMR for recertification.
 - b. Mark asked about a bridge for EMR's to not need to retest for recertification.
 - i. Problem is no EMR certification number with CDPHE.
 - ii. CLFPD has many EMRs needing to recertification.

- iii. No EMR training can be logged into Medic CE without EMR certification number.
- iv. Question will current EMRs receive notification from Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).
- c. Apparent numerous EMT and EMR needing to recertify in March, 2020.
- d. Kevin requested all NLCERA departments send their EMS training rosters to PFA (To: amaddox@poudrefire.org) for entry verification and entry into MedicCE.
- e. Moving forward NLCERA EMS monthly training will be entered into MedicCE for from rosters like George used to do.
- f. Kevin will call CDPHE to better guide NLCERA departments regarding EMR certs.
- c. Five Pillars of EMS Compliance (Protocols, Response, QA, Equipment, and Training):
 - i. Protocols
 - 1. Latest update went live February 1, 2020 on PPP App and Weblink at NLCERA.org website.
 - 2. Questions about the changes in the protocols
 - a. PFA received a question about the DNR requirements of the Northern Colorado Prehospital Protocols (NCPP).
 - Kevin explained the differences between the NCPP and Colorado State legislated requirements.
 - ii. Advice to follow NCPP protocols and call medical control if a question while on an emergency scene.
 - 3. Review PPP App update process
 - a. Plan is to update PPP in January and July, unless required by medical director more often.
 - ii. Response
 - 1. NLCERA EMS rural fourth-quarter 2019 data file sent to rural chiefs for their review.
 - a. Data file reviewed by Aaron for each department, and aggregate as NLCERA Rural EMS.
 - b. Request for feedback if the NLCERA EMS data being sent to the rural chiefs is helpful? What other needs or requests for data?
 - c. Response data may drive training needs in the future.
 - 2. MARVLIS update to "Demand" programing on May 1, 2020

- a. Aaron provided an overview of the plan to change from a mix of geography and demand, to a demand only programing in MARVLIS.
 - i. Discussion and questions about how this will affect response in rural areas.
 - 1. MARVLIS, in combination with AVL dispatching with new CAD, should recommend the closest unit.
 - 2. Postings will need to be monitored, but letting the program run should predict where ambulances will be needed.
 - 3. PFA Commitment that rural NLCERA will receive an ambulance within EMS Contract compliant times.
- 3. IFT changes effects on NLCERA response
 - a. Aaron provided an overview regarding the 911 generated interfacility transfers (IFT) which began to have a BLS component in September, 2019. In September, the 911 system ran approximately 81 IFTs per month.
 - i. Current 911 system IFTs are showing approximat 41% reduction (50 IFts) due to non-911 IFT capacity from UCHealth.
 - ii. The 911 system having BLS IFT capability helps keep ALS ambulances available in the NLCERA.
- 4. Discussion regarding rendezvous with UCHealth ambulances responding with two wheel drive ambulances.
 - a. The apparent issue has been for the AHJ to need to respond to the UCH ambulance and take the crew to the scene.
 - b. PFA requested for departments having issues with rendezvous or two wheel drive access to use the NLCERA.org Operational Form to provide details and request a review.
- 5. NLCERA Feedback Form use
 - a. PFA requests the NLCERA departments use the forms on the NLCERA.org webpage to communicate NLCERA needs or feedback.

iii. OA

- 1. First Pass update regarding patient care feedback
 - a. Follow-up from November 16:
 - i. Rural Departments choice of PCR format?
 - 1. A PCR is required for all medicals per the medical director.

- 2. Discussion from November, 2019 minutes: Examples of <u>PCR written</u> report formats included as Appendix-C.
- 3. The AED and Auto-Pulse PCR data will assist with Q/A of the responses.
- 4. PFA is working towards full QA for all NLCERA EMS responses
- ii. Update of what EPCR programs in use for 2020
 - 1. Red Feather is upgrading to ESO in the near future for PCRs and data.
 - 2. Emergency Reporting and Colorado Image Trend are other two EPCR programs in use by NLCERA departmens.
 - 3. PFA uses Image Trend and UCH uses ESO
- b. Discussion about clinical care QA reviews can drive development of distance learning opportunities.

iv. Equipment

- 1. UCH Glucometer change on February 1, 2020
 - a. Discussion about PFA's commitment regarding information and training for any new equipment on UCH ambulances.
 - b. Training will be integrated into monthly EMS trainings.

v. Training

- 1. Monthly Training
 - a. Discussion about needing more IV sticks
 - i. Simulation training is an option and can be built into EMS training rotations.
 - ii. Kevin PFA offers an IV class at the end of every fire academy class
 - 1. Possible to offer training spots to rural NLCERA folks.
 - 2. Need to work out the workmans comp issues.
 - b. Update about new UCH Educators
 - i. New UCHealth Educators are now onboard
 - 1. Offices are at PFA Training Center
 - 2. MedicCE will be a part of their responsibility
 - 3. The NLCERA EMS training calendar will be updated with more specific details, such as topics and CE information.
 - c. EMT Class availability update

- i. Warren question where to have aspiring EMTs obtain a hybrid online/practical class?
 - 1. PFA has no capacity at this time to sponsor or coordinate for the NLCERA.
 - 2. Recommendation to contact RETAC
 - a. Warren to contact Jeff Shannels.
 - b. RETAC may have grant funds available for regional EMT class.
 - c. Warren wants to update GVFPD Station 1 as distance learning location with upgraded AV and IT.
 - 3. Question if local community colleges could sponsor?
 - a. PFA can possibly assist with skills portions.
 - b. Discussion of out of state online classes as an option.
 - c. Suggestion to contact Front Range and AIMS.

 - ii. PFA encourages use and comments regarding the NLCERA.org website.
- e. UCHealth updates
 - i. UCH EMS Organizational Chart changes and updates
 - 1. Addition of clinical mentors and educators
 - ii. Non-911 IFT update
 - 1. UCHealth is establishing a non-911 IFT capacity completely outside of 911 EMS Contract.
 - iii. UCH Reserve Program update
 - 1. Currently the Reserve Program is being reviewed by UCHealth Risk Management.
 - 2. EMT Ride-alongs available now contact Monique Rose: monique.rose@uchealth.org
 - a. Discussion about the what agreements are needed for the AHJ's to cover insurances for their EMTs on ridealongs
 - 3. Discussion about if PFA engines are available for ride-alongs.
 - a. Kevin to research options and report back.
 - b. Warren to take the lead for the rural EMS departments
- f. NLCERA Fourth-Quarter 2019 Data
 - i. October-December, 2019 Compliance Zones 3-5
 - 1. Overview and discussion by Aaron.
 - 2. UCHealth compliant in all zones with EMS Contract

- ii. Overview of response data per department as compared to previous years.
 - 1. Aaron presented data comparisons for each AHJ of the rural NLCERA.
 - 2. Feedback requested about the data content and level of detail.

g. NLCERA R-E Status

- i. Overview of October December R-E's
- ii. PFA and UCH are working towards an R-E which will change MARVLIS programing.
 - 1. Mostly affect zone 1 percentile times being measured to assess improvements moving forward.

4. NLCERA Fire/EMS Agency updates?

- a. Warren (GVFPD) Expressed he is pleased to be back at GVFPD as their Fire Chief. He is committed to promoting interagency cooperation and training.
- b. Hugh (PCFPD) Advised the new station 4 is being occupied with temporary CO.
- c. Joel (LFPD) Asked about the NLCERA Patient hand-off and patient care refusal forms. Where can they obtain more?
 - i. Apparently the hand-off form was a UCHealth form.
 - ii. Patient hand-off forms Vanessa ordered and distributed.
 - iii. Discussion of tablet based system could solve this need.
 - iv. Discussion about the need to keep NLCERA standardized format.
 - v. Ryan (GVFPD) to follow-up regarding ordering NLCERA Refusal and Patient hand-off forms.
 - vi. Restocking Question Joel asked if possible to have a restocking cabinet from UCH?
 - 1. PFA advised UCH cannot provide a restocking cabinet to the rural departments.
 - a. Concern expressed that if no ambulance arrives, such as with air resources transporting that supplies are not replaced.
 - b. PFA advised to call the UCH Deployment Coordinator phone number and request replacement supplies used: 970-689-2462
- d. Bobby (RFLFPD) RF will have ESO and tablets for EMS response in the near future.
 - i. Discussion of how ESO and tablets can be used for resource tracking as well.
